How did this event come about?

The Carquez family have a history of giving to the community. Kimmi's father, Victor, held many fundraisers at his former restaurant, The Star Diner. Kimmi is carrying on the family tradition by holding a 24-hour event for Kingston Literacy and local schools. Kimmi has generously offered up the use of her restaurant, staff and family, as well as approached suppliers for food, and recruited many volunteers to assist in the day's events.

What is going to make this event so special?

During each hour of the event, we will have something special going on, celebrities on hand to top up your coffee, draws for door prizes, and cool activities (poetry reading, story-telling, bookmaking workshop...). Check out the draft schedule on the next page.

How will this event raise funds for Kingston Literacy and get books for area schools?

There will be no set cost for menu items (we will note on the special menu what items usually cost). We will be asking patrons to pay what they want. Every cent that people pay during this 24-hour period will be donated to Kingston Literacy: this is not just the profit after expenses, but the entire amount. How can Kimmi's Kitchen do this? All workers are generously donating their time, most supplies have been donated by generous vendors, like Cakes & Crafts, Findlay Foods and Mother Parker's Coffee, and Kimmi is donating her restaurant for an entire 24 hours. We are also inviting the public to bring in quality children's books, which will be used in area schools.
